Foxes

Foxes have launched themselves into Space, navigating their way around the planets, the phases of the moon and the Space Race. They have created newspaper reports documenting Neil Armstrong's first steps on the moon, his most famous quotes, and the events leading up to this. In mathematics, we have been focussing on all areas of fractions – taking time out to understand what a fraction looks like before beginning the calculations. An amazing few weeks of learning!









Squirrels

Over the past few weeks, Squirrels have been having a 'marvellous' time in their learning, particularly being able to use the text George's Marvellous Medicine in their English lessons to find grammar elements; we have looked at plurals, expanded noun phrases and what roles sentences can have. We have also been exploring Europe using atlases and mapping out food miles for certain food imported to our country before looking at the nutritional value of foods. We are becoming masters at our mathematics now too, with using formal column methods with addition and subtraction and we are excited to start using this with word problems.







Badgers

In Year One and Two, the children have had an exciting few weeks! Delving into history, they explored the Gunpowder Plot and Guy Fawkes, captivated by the consequences he faced. Their geography skills soared as they discovered the five major oceans and mastered locating the equator on a world map. Amidst this, they joyfully began practising for the upcoming nativity play. What a whirlwind of discovery and preparation—here's to many more engaging weeks ahead!

EYFS have had lots of fun learning about space over these past few weeks!! This week they have had fun learning about rockets and showed great creativity making their own rockets using a range of construction materials! Children have also been practising writing numerals 1-10 as well as building their

phonic knowledge!
