Every library book has a unique barcode - this is on the inside of the cover. When your child loans a book they too have their own barcode. The two marry together and we have a record of which book they have loaned and when it was. The computer system can show us: - how many books we have in the library, books by a particular author, <u>all</u> the books your child has ever loaned, which books are the most popular and much much more!
