News from the classes...

Owls

Owls have had a great start to the new half term. We started with STEM week last week, looking at our planet and how we can be kinder to make sure it is here for future generations. We began our space topic with a visit from The Black Hole Planetarium which we loved and in our topic work we are learning all about space starting by comparing the planets in our solar system and creating some beautiful artwork for our book covers.







Moles

We have had a fantastic couple of weeks in Moles class. We really enjoyed STEM week where we read the book 'The Planet in a Pickle Jar' which taught us all about the importance of looking after our planet. We have produced some fantastic work too, including a miniature solar system, bar charts and we have also been practising our map reading skills! We are very much looking forward to getting stuck into our new topic!









Rabbits

Rabbits have started the second term with an action-packed STEM week! We read the story 'The Planet in a Pickle Jar' which inspired our learning, looking at; memories, our solar system, recycling and upcycling, how our food decomposes and keeping healthy which the children thoroughly enjoyed.

Our new topic 'Why do we celebrate?' has started with a bang, as we develop our understanding of The Gunpowder Plot and explore different celebrations. In phonics we are moving through the extended code and in English we have been working on Riddles. What a great start, well done Rabbits.









Caterpillars

What a lovely start to the half term! The children have had so much fun exploring and engaging in all the lovely activities. They are settling in to our daily routine well and are very much enjoying pre-school life! We have had some amazing activities out this week, with lots of lovely learning opportunities to be had. They have all enjoyed sharing the story 'Owl Babies' by Martin Waddell and Patrick Benson. The children have been re-telling the story, creating fantastic pictures and getting messy with sensory play!
